

Information of How to Vote for the Upcoming Gas Municipalization Election August 2, 2011

- 1. Registered voters of Pocahontas can vote the day of the election at the Assembly Room of the Courthouse. Polls will be open from 12pm to 8pm.**
- 2. If you are not registered to vote, you can register at the polls before you vote. Just remember to bring your drivers license and proof of residence (city utility bill or bank statement).**
- 3. People have the option of voting by absentee ballot. This can be done by going to the Auditor's Office and filling out an absentee ballot now through August 2nd until 11:00am. If you are not registered to vote you can register the same time you fill out an absentee ballot. The Auditor's office is open Monday through Friday 8am-4pm including the noon hour.**
- 4. If you would like to request an absentee ballot to be sent to your residence you must submit that request in writing to the Auditor's office or you can call City Hall and we can bring you the form to request an absentee ballot.**
- 5. Absentee ballots must be post marked by August 1, 2011 and received by the Auditor no later than August 8, 2011 to be counted in the election. Absentee ballots cannot be sent out by the Auditor's office no later than July 29, 2011.**
- 6. You may also pick up voter registration and absentee ballot request forms from City Hall Monday through Friday 7:30am -4pm.**
- 7. If you have any questions about absentee voting or voter registration, contact the Pocahontas County Auditor's office at 335-3361.**
